The question of how trade with the developed countries can benefit or hurt India is also considered. It is shown that by exporting industrial goods, the labour force employed in agriculture can be reduced and the poor in India made better off. Finally, the book examines why India s industrial policy from Independence until very recently has stifled entrepreneurship and undermined technical change in industry.
